Who counts as American? When a turbaned Sikh man is brutally murdered in the aftermath of Sept. 11, a college student journeys across the country to find out who counts as “one of us” in a world divided into “us and them.” Armed with only a camera, she captures hundreds of stories never before told – stories of fear and unspeakable loss, but also of resilience and hope – until she finally finds the heart of America, halfway around the world. Four years in the making, *Divided We Fall* weaves expert analysis into a cross-country road trip that confronts the forces dividing Americans in times of crisis.
